#### Members of AMD64 enjoyed the "Roast Beef of Olde England" at the Toby Carvery, Ewell.




## Brother Glyn Harvey

It is with great sadness that we learnt of the sudden passing of Companion Glyn Harvey on the 30th of December 2023. As most of you may be aware, Glyn had been unwell for some time, but his sudden passing was shock to many of us.

Glyn, whose occupation was a Professional Classical Musician, was initiated into the Royal Dental Hospital Lodge No. 7099, London, in November 1983. He was a member of nine Craft Lodges and achieved the ranks of SLGR, and PProvGSuptWks (Surrey).

He was Exalted into Sterndale Bennet Chapter No 2182, London, in June 1986 and held the ranks of PPGSoj (West Kent), and PProvDepGSwdB (Surrey). Glyn was also a member of ten of the Companions Orders under Mark Masons Hall, as well as the Ancient and Accepted Rite, where he used to play the organ at their church services. He was Admitted into Kyngstun Council in May 2006, was a Founder of Surrey Hills Council in 2007, and Joined Surrey Council in 2011.

Glyn was also the Provincial/District Grand Organist in several of the Companion Orders including the Provincial Priories of



Kent and Surrey, as well as the District of Surrey in the Royal and Select Masters. He was also Deputy Great Organist in Great Priory from 2012 to 2015.

But for most of us he will be remembered for conducting the Provincial Choir at the Annual Services of Thanksgiving held at Guildford Cathedral, and the Royal Arch Christmas Carol Services held at Woodham and Beddington.

Who can forget Glyn leading us through his own rendition of the 12 Days of Christmas. One of the highlights of the year.
